Grandfather Period to End September 30th, 2016

For students pursuing either the WCCA or WCCP programs and who have taken either:

CA16A: Permanent Disability Rating and AMA Guides, Basic

or

CA16B: Permanent Disability and AMA Guides, Advanced

and

Have not yet completed the WCCA Certificate or WCCP Designation, this notice affects YOU!

What's Happening?

The Institutes' requirements to earn the WCCA and WCCP designations have changed, and the Grandfather period for accepting CA16a and CA16b will end Sept 30, 2016.

What does this mean to me?

- If you have taken CA16a but will not complete WCCA by Sept 30, 2016, you will need to take the new WCCA15 (along with the other requirements) to earn the WCCA.
- If you have taken CA16b but will not complete WCCP by Sept 30, 2016, you will need to take WCCP 16 (along with the other requirements) to earn the WCCP
