MBR: Medical Bill Review Adjuster

MBR – Medical Bill Review Adjuster requires 40 hours with 30 in a classroom. Required statutory topic courses include, but are not limited to

- (1) Historical Overview
- (4) Concepts and terminology
- (5) WC benefits provisions
- (16) fraud
- (17) Medical terminology
- (18) UR
- (19) Medical Evidence
- (21) Billing Codes fee schedules
- (22) Liens
- (26) Ethical issues.

Required Modules

- This will require taking 10 of 24 sections of the course at 3 hours each, without completion of homework modules + Billing Codes.
- Required seminars are modules 1,2,7,8,9,10,11,12,13,14.
- Billing Codes currently needs to be taken separately. Proof of completion will need to be submitted before receiving certificate.

Continuing Education Requirement

Six hours of continuing education in workers' compensation or disability management are required each year. Please see the CPWC program page on IEA's website.
